What is a Parish Plan?

A Parish Plan is an opportunity for a community to play an active part in determining its own future.

A Parish Plan involves all residents, young and old, and is an opportunity for everyone's voice to be heard.

A Parish Plan will provide good evidence of the needs and wishes of that community.

Why a Parish Plan

The information gained and results obtained by a Plan belong to that community and is evidence of their needs and wishes which will be difficult to ignore. It is an opportunity to gain funding from external agencies to help to improve village facilities and services.

Who undertakes a Parish Plan?

The idea for a Plan can be started by anyone in the community and Eltisley Parish Council thinks a Parish Plan is a good idea and has already been awarded funding from DeFRA to enable a questionnaire to be drawn up and circulated to every home in the village later this year analysed and an action plan drawn up.

The most important priority is to get the support and views of the community as a whole – including young people. Everyone has something to offer, be it skills, experience, time, useful contacts or local knowledge.

Ultimately the success of the project hinges on the involvement of the community as a whole.
